





The Walk Forward Process

- 1. Determine a time frame to test and calibrate your parameters.
- 2. Walk the system forward over the immediate future data it hasn't been tested over.




Determine a time frame for Calibration.


Then walk forward those parameters over the next data set.

If you tossed bricks off a truck, which kind of pile of bricks would you more likely produce?




Disorder is more probable than order.



One of the ideas involved in the concept of entropy is that nature tends from order to disorder in isolated systems. This tells us that the right hand box of molecules happened before the left. Using Newton's laws to describe the motion of the molecules would not tell you which came first

ENTROPY is one of the laws of Thermodynamics. It basically means the further you get away from an event, the more disorder that will occur. 10




